

Simple. Holiness Made Simple (Colossians 3:1-17)

- 1. Describe a time when you showed up somewhere like an event, a trip, or a celebration wearing the wrong clothing. (Some examples include: dressing casually for an important business meeting by accident, wearing a t-shirt and shorts to a get together that was actually a formal party, forgetting to wear a costume to a costume party, etc.)
- 2. How does it feel to be over or under dressed for something? What do your clothes potentially communicate about yourself to others?

Read Colossians 3:1-17

- 3. What is the difference between true holiness and counterfeit holiness?
- 4. On a daily basis what does it look like to be 'in Christ'? How will it affect the way I make decisions? How will it affect my relationships with my family and friends?
- 5. How would you define the new self? What's been different in you since following Jesus? How have your actions also changed?
- 6. How can we help each other with ongoing temptation? Do you have an accountability partner who will ask the hard questions?
- 7. What does it look like to put to death the old self and its habits? How have you done this in your own life?
- 8. How have you experienced the renewing of your mind as a Christian? In what ways are you more like Jesus than when you first believed?
- 9. In verses 15-17 Paul shares some marks of a thriving church. Dave mentioned four peace, word of God, worship and motivation. Are there others we should note?
- 10. What evidence do you observe of these marks being seen in CBC?
- 11. Verse 13 says to forgive others as God has forgiven us. What does it look like to forgive someone? How have you seen forgiveness at work in your life?
- 12. Using verses 12-14 pray that these qualities will be more and more evident in your life.
