

## The Holy Spirt & Freedom (2 Corinthians 3:17-18)

- 1. Think of a bible verse that speaks about freedom. What does this verse mean for you?
- 2. The Israelites were led by God from their captivity in Egypt how do you think they felt when Egypt was just an image in their rear view mirror? What emotions would they have experienced?

## Read 2 Corinthians 3 together

- 3. Most people want to be free so that they can do whatever they want. They may want to be emotionally, politically, financially, relationally free so that there are no boundaries or constraints. Usually this desire to be free means serving whom?
- 4. Where are you inclined to indulge yourself in the name of your freedom in Christ?
- 5. License is a way of thinking that seeks to celebrate freedom in Christ by doing away with any standard of holy living. Would you say that this kind of thinking exists among Christians today? If so, in what ways? How does this kind of thinking manifest itself in the lives of believers?
- 6. According to Galatians 5:13-14, what is the goal and end result of Christian liberty?
- 7. When you sense you are being condemned by that voice inside how do you deal with it? What sort of things does our enemy accuse us of?
- 8. Is there such a thing as sinless perfection in this life? Read 1John 2:1 how does this help our understanding of the Christian and sin?
- 9. Can we ever be free from fear? What practical things have helped you when you were afraid?
- 10. What practically would it look like in your daily life to more readily 'walk' or 'keep in step' with the Spirit?
