



To The Crowds | John 12:12-19

1. The crowds seemed to follow Jesus everywhere. What impact do you think they had on Jesus and his ministry?
2. In What ways did Jesus and his ministry have an impact on the crowds that followed him? (Luke 6:20, Mark 10:46ff, Luke 13:10-16, Mark 2:16-17, Mark 6:34ff, John 12:12-19, Luke 20:1-8 etc. etc.)
3. Consider the response of the crowd in words and actions as Jesus rode into Jerusalem. How different was this to their responses on other occasions. (John 2:18, 23-25, John 4:40-41, John 5:16, John 6:24, 41-42, 52, 66-67, John 7:25-32, 41-44)
4. How do you think a large crowd might respond today if Jesus appeared to them?
5. Discuss:- “The gospels are a passion narrative with an extended introduction.” Why do you think the gospel writers have done this?
