



Bible Study | Matthew 7:24–27

1. What stands out to you in this passage? Why do you think Jesus chose the imagery of building houses on rock and sand?
2. What does it mean to “hear” and to “do” the words of Jesus? How can we discern if we’re only hearing and not doing?
3. Why do you think the house on the rock withstood the storm while the other collapsed? How does this apply to our spiritual lives?
4. Chris' message mentioned living in a world full of “voices.” What voices in your life compete with God’s voice right now?
5. Chris said, “There is one voice that stands eternal.” How do you prioritise God's voice in your day-to-day life?
6. The wise builder “puts Jesus’ words into practice.” What are some specific ways you’ve tried to live out Jesus’ teachings recently?
7. Think of a recent “storm” or challenge in your life. What foundation did you find yourself standing on? Rock or sand?
8. What spiritual disciplines (e.g. prayer, Scripture reading, service) help you build a stronger foundation? How do you ensure these practices are transformative, not just informative...?
9. Is there an area of your life where you’ve been more of a “hearer” than a “doer”? What’s one step you could take this week to begin living that out?
10. Pray together for hearts that not only hear the Word but live it. Ask God to reveal areas in your lives that need rebuilding on His foundation.
