In-Person Prayer Gathering - This coming Tuesday lunchtime (10 February) we will be gathering in-person at 12.15pm in the Christian Centre for soup & a roll before praying 12.30-1.15pm. Please do join us if you possibly can.

CBC Art Group - This art group will next meet on Wednesday 11 February, 10.00am to 12.30pm in the Christian Centre. It's free to come along and anyone is welcome! Alpha is a relaxed, welcoming space where people can ask honest questions, feel heard, and explore faith at their own pace. So pray, think of one or two people, and take the simple step of inviting them. It really does make all the difference.
