**Message From Christchurch Foodbank+** - Thank you for your continued and faithful support. As we walk into Autumn and Harvest-time we are getting our preparations ready for our second busiest time of year, Christmas. Alongside our normal parcels we gave out an additional 180 packed lunches 450 blocks of cheese, 571 bags of fresh fruit and veg, and enough School Holiday hunger parcels to feed over 1100 mouths during the summer holidays. Our shelves now need your help, we are asking for donations of tinned fruit, tinned peas and carrots, custard, tuna, tinned tomatoes, soup and boxes of cereal. *Donated food items can be placed in the boxes in the foyer of church.*
