4. What future hope and promise does God make to his people in Micah that actually benefits us today?
5. What other examples in the Bible can you think of that show Gods merciful love? The following references will give you some. Luke 15, 2 Chronicles 33, 1 Kings 21, Jonah 4:11, Luke 23:34.
6. Consider sharing together personal ways in which we have received and been blessed by 'God's merciful love. And as a church at CBC as well.
7. Consider what steps and action we can take to show God's merciful love to those close to us and also to our community.
